



MATERIALS MANAGEMENT SUPPORT

As defined by our colleagues at the Construction Industry Institute (CII), materials management is a complex and comprehensive process involving people, organizations, technologies, and processes that manage the definition, sourcing, planning, quantification, supplier qualification, purchasing, supplier QA/QC, expediting, transportation, logistics, and control of materials and associated information across the life cycle of a capital project. Materials and related services account for a large percentage of a capital project's total installed cost (TIC). Implementation of a materials management program contributes to predictable project outcomes, reduced costs, improved productivity, and quality. Areas where PRG can add value include:
